



## Notice of Opportunity

**The Spar Shop** at Grays Harbor Historical Seaport has a contract with Mystic Seaport to turn two new yards for the ***Joseph Conrad***.

As a result, within the next four to six weeks a “long load” flatbed will be driving cross country from Aberdeen, WA to the East Coast.

Grays Harbor Historical Seaport is offering a cooperative shipping opportunity to ASTA member organizations. If any ASTA members wish to order or ship spars, cants or timbers, this is an opportunity for significant savings on shipping costs for ASTA members and Mystic Seaport.

The truck will depart Aberdeen, WA in mid-April. At this time it appears that there may be one stop in New York, other stops are possible. If you are a member of the American Sail Training Association and you need Spars or large timbers delivered from the West coast, Grays Harbor Historical Seaport is willing to help arrange for space on this load, as long as it lasts.
